Contribute to a Special Issue of ERNOP Research Notes on Justice Philanthropy

- 4. **Publish & Share:** Your Research Note will be reviewed, approved, and published on the ERNOP website, with your name and organization for recognition if you wish. We will also distribute the Special Issue at the Philea Forum 2025.



Creating a Research Note will take approximately **4 hours**, and you'll have a **6-week timeframe** to complete it after being matched with an article.

- Can understand and interpret academic research and translate it into practical, easy-to-read summaries.
- Are committed to advancing philanthropy by contributing to more equitable and just practices.
